Hong Kong Container Terminal Operators Association Supports Hong Kong SAR Government proposal to split the Transport and Housing Bureau

All members of the Hong Kong Container Terminal Operators Association (HKCTOA) have expressed their support for the Hong Kong SAR Government's proposal to re-organise the government structure, in particular splitting the current Transport and Housing Bureau (THB) into two bureaux namely "Housing Bureau" and "Transport and Logistics Bureau", announced by the Chief Executive of Hong

Kong SAR Mrs Carrie Lam on 12 January 2022.

Under the proposal, all issues related to transport and logistics would be handled by the newly formed Transport and Logistics Bureau, which is essential for Hong

Kong to enhance its position as an international maritime centre.

In the past few years, housing issues have become a high priority for the Hong Kong community and it has taken up most of the resources from THB. Splitting THB into Housing Bureau and Transport and Logistics Bureau is very important for both sectors as the Government can properly allocate dedicated resources to

address relevant issues in a more effective manner.

With an aim to maintain the competitiveness of the Port of Hong Kong and to enhance Hong Kong's position as an international shipping centre and transshipment hub, HKCTOA therefore supports the Hong Kong SAR Government's proposal to split the THB into the two mentioned bureaux and looks

forward to its successful implementation
